

Work at Bays Mountain Park!

SEASONAL CONTRACT: JUNIOR COUNSELOR, SUMMER DAY CAMP

Qualifications:

Must be, at minimum, a high school senior who has been accepted into a college or university for Fall 2022, or a college freshman, sophomore or junior. Major course of study should be in natural history, or related field, but other disciplines will be considered, especially if the applicant has experience working with children. The candidate must have an overall C+ average for the last academic year and a B in his/her academic field. The candidate must be recommended by a faculty member in his/her major department. Financial need of applicants will not be a factor in selecting a recipient of the scholarship.

Definition:

Work 40 hours per week from late May to early August at Bays Mountain Park. Some weekend and evening work will be required. Duties will include, but not be limited to, organization, direction and leading the park's day camp program for children ages six through eleven-years-old; becoming familiar with local flora and fauna as well as the park's cultural history. After a reasonable period of orientation, successful candidate must be able to present public programs, and be under supervision of senior counselor and a park naturalist staff member. No room or board will be provided by Bays Mountain Park or BMPA.

SEASONAL CONTRACT: SENIOR COUNSELOR SUMMER DAY CAMP

Qualifications:

College junior who will complete his/her junior year by mid-May 2022, a senior who has been accepted for graduate school; or a currently enrolled graduate student having at least one year to complete graduate study. Major course of study should be in natural history or related field, but other disciplines will be considered, especially if the applicant has experience working with children. The candidate must have an overall C+ average for the last academic year and a B in his/her academic field. Candidates must be recommended by a faculty member in his/her major department. Financial need of applicants will not be a factor in selecting a recipient of the scholarship.

Definition:

Work 40 hours per week from late May to early August at Bays Mountain Park. Some weekend and evening work will be required. Duties will include, but not be limited to, organization, direction and leading the park's day camp program for children ages six through eleven-years-old; becoming familiar with local flora and fauna as well as the park's cultural history. After a reasonable period of orientation, successful candidate must be able to present public programs; supervise up to two assistants; and be under supervision of Operations Coordinator and a park naturalist staff member. No room or board will be provided by Bays Mountain Park or BMPA.

To Apply:

Send resume including name, primary mailing address, and phone number(s) of three references, at least one of which should be a faculty member in candidate's major department. Cover letter may be included. Desire, experience, and ability to work with visitors in both an indoor and outdoor environment will be of special interest to the selection committee. Finally, we request a copy of candidate's transcript be sent along with the resume. Upon review of all applications, the most qualified candidates will be contacted for interviews.
